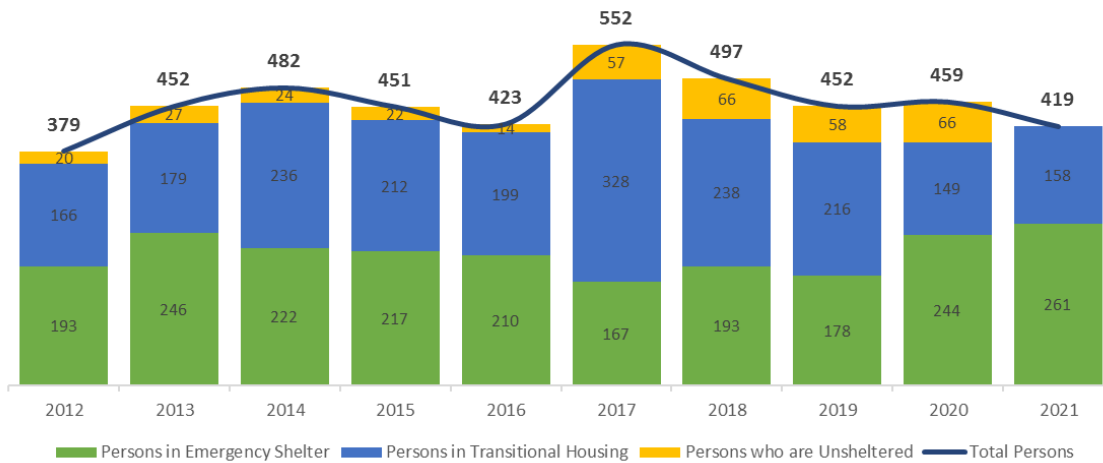


# Point-in-Time Count MN-502 Rochester/Southeast Minnesota CoC

## Historical Trends, 2012-2021

Total Persons Sheltered & Unsheltered in One-Night Count, by year



The **Point-in-Time Count** is conducted on one night in the last 10 days of January each year. Staff and volunteers at agencies throughout the 20-county Rochester/Southeast Minnesota CoC region assist in the Point-in-Time Count.

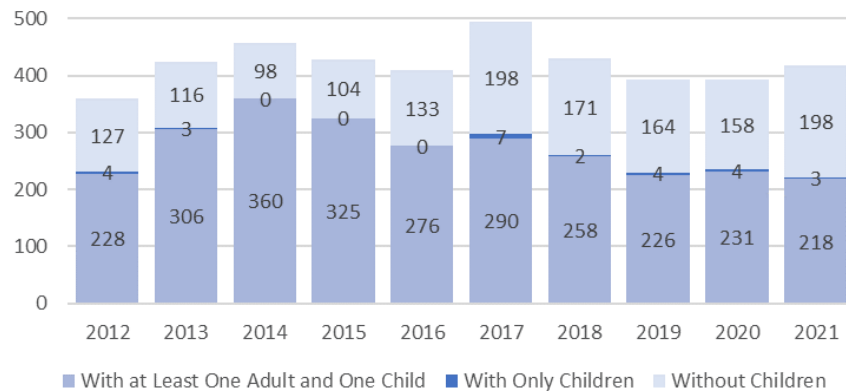
Point-in-Time Counts provide a one-night snapshot of homelessness. Persons who are unsheltered and persons who are in temporary shelter are counted. Surveys are conducted when possible.

The data is used to assist the CoC planning group as well as local, state, and federal agencies to allocate resources to end homelessness for individuals and families. The count also meets a federal requirement for some homeless program funding in the region.
